## PLANTS THAT ATTRACT BIRDS

### Trees for Birds

Ash—Rosehill White Ash, *Fraxinus americana* 'Rosehill' and Summit Green Ash, *Fraxinus pennsylvanica* 'Summit'.

Coastal Redwoods—Majestic Beauty, Santa Cruz and Soquel, *Sequoia sempervirens*.

Dogwoods—Gouchauti and Sibirica, *Cornus alba*, and Flaviramea and Isanti, *Cornus sericea*.

Laurel—Bright n'Tight, *Prunus carolinian* 'Monus'.

Magnolia—Little Gem, Majestic Beauty, and St. Mary, *Magnolia grandiflora*.

Maples—Red Sunset, *Acer rubrum* 'Franksred' and Sugar Maple, *Acer saccharum*.

Mountain Ash—Coral Fire, *Sorbus hupehensis*.

Oaks—California Oak, *Quercus agrifolia*, English Oak, *Quercus rubra*, and Southern Live Oak, *Quercus virginiana*.

Redbuds—Forest Pansy, Alba and Silver Cloud, *Cercis canadensis*, and Oklahoma and Texas White, *Cercis reniformis*.

River Birch, Red Birch—*Betula nigra*

Sweet Gum—Burgundy, Festival, Palo Alto, and Rotundiloba, *Liquidambar styraciflua*.

### Shrubs for Birds

Bog Rosemary—*Andromeda polifolia* 'Nana'

Brush Cherry—Globus and Monterey Bay, *Eugenia myrtifolia*.

Butterfly Weed—*Asclepias tuberosa*

Carolina Allspice—*Calycaanthus floridus*

Compact Texas Sage—*Leucophyllum frutescens* 'Compaactum'.

Confederate Rose—*Hibiscus mutabilis* 'Rubrus'.

Coralberry, Indian Currant—*Symphoricarpos orbiculatus*
