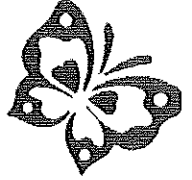


PLANTS THAT ATTRACT BUTTERFLIES

Plants provide food, shelter, and nesting sites for butterflies. The successful butterfly garden provides both nectar and host plants, a water source (a large shallow plate or a few rocks placed in your birdbath), and places for hiding and resting. Take care when tidying the garden so as not to disturb butterflies, chrysalides, caterpillars, or eggs... maybe even leave a small unkempt area just for butterflies.
